The Wollongong City Gallery are once again offering specialist art workshops for our students.

The Year 1 and 2 workshops will focus on the “Jewels in the Crown” exhibition. The day will include drawing and painting activities that will allow students to explore their own interpretations of home and place. The end result will be a large scale artwork that students will take home. Cost for the workshops is \$36.50 and this amount is not refundable.

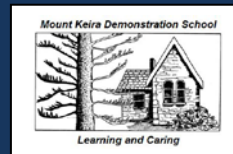
Year 3-6 have the opportunity to attend a free workshop based on Bob Sredersas’ story. Students will tour this multi-media installation, with the study focus being on the positive contribution that both migrants and refugees have had on our local communities. Students will learn the history behind Bob Sredersas’s story, Wollongong Art Gallery’s collection and will discuss and document their visions when thinking about the future of Wollongong and their local communities. This will be done through the art of paper collage. Student collages will be transformed into a collaborative stop motion animation. To end the day, students will focus on the painting, Herring Fleet by famous Australian painter, Sydney Long. Students will complete an appropriated version of this artwork. There is no cost for this program.

Years 5 and 6 students may also attend a ceramics program. The day will begin with a tour of East Meets West with a focus on the work by contemporary ceramic artists, Gerry Wedd and Vipoo Srivilasa. Students will learn hand building techniques to create their own ceramic artwork which will reflect upon their own cultural heritage. Curriculum and syllabus links will be made in reference to visual arts. Cost of this program is \$36.50.

Parents must make their own arrangements to take their children to and from the gallery. Please note that the students attending the workshop will not be accompanied by a teacher from Mount Keira.
