

# **Blocked Toilets**

Over the past few weeks we have had many call outs to fix the student toilet block as the systems were not functioning correctly. Unfortunately over the weekend it was bought to our attention that the toilet pipe was blocked; having over two metres of hand towel blocking the pipe.

We are asking for your assistance in raising awareness. Please discuss with your child that **under NO circumstance are paper or hand towel to be flushed down the toilets.** In additional, if you are sending your child to school with wet ones or paper sanitisers, please make them aware that these items **MUST be placed in the toilet bins at all times.** 

This gradual build up is costing the school a large amount of money and a huge amount of work for our local neighbours who are unfortunately left to clean up after the pipe has been blocked and exploded in their yard.

Thank you for your support in discussing this issue at home.

#### Hygiene at School

School children are exposed to all kinds of germs and bacteria that they wouldn't usually come into contact with at home. It is vital that students understand the importance of hygiene and are ensuring they are practicing good hygiene whilst at school.

There are many viruses going around our school at the moment. Please remind you child to:

- Wash their hands correctly with soap
- Cover their mouths when coughing or sneezing
- Place tissues in the bins immediately after use
- Avoid sharing personal items eg hats
- Avoid sharing food and drinks
- Have regular baths or showers
- Wear clean clothes regularly
- Cover any open wounds with bandaids or other dressings to avoid contamination

If your child is unwell or contagious, please contact your local doctor to seek further advice and keep your child home until they are well enough to return to school.

Please also stress to your child that they should not touch any other children's wounds, blood or sores. If their friend has an injury or illness they should be taken to the office to receive the appropriate treatment.

#### **Selective High School Placement for 2020**

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly based on the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores.

The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on **Thursday 14 March 2019**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2020, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from mid-September 2018 at https:// education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7. The application website opens at that link on **9 October 2018** and closes on **12 November 2018**. You must **apply before the closing date.** As requisted in the notice sent home last term please advise our school if you are applying so that we can ensure your application is received in the system.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 9 October 2018.

You must submit only **ONE** application for each student.
