A new addition to this ceremony was the ringing of our old black bell, 11 times at 11 o'clock following the minute's silence. It was actually a very emotional moment as our old black bell, rung by Kobi, tolled across the playground and over Mount Keira, although it did cause the magpies to take flight!
