National award winners


Further to our story last week about the **NATIONAL** Playground Design Award for Infants and Primary Schools and the Leycester Meares Memorial Award. Here are our trophies!







This term we have been looking at different types of imaginative writing including literary descriptions and poetry techniques. Have a read of our writing samples and the creative spine poetry we have created.

















End of year activities

We are currently finalising our end of year events, ensuring they meet the most current COVID guidelines. The new guidelines allow for parents to be involved only when the physical space allows for 1.5m distancing and 4m² per individual. This included students, staff and visitors.

To be COVID safe and compliant, we need to plan all arrangements on the total number of students and staff likely to attend before we can invite visitors. This requirement means, we will only be able to invite Year 6 parents to our end of year **Graduation Assembly**. There will be a limit of two adults per child to ensure we maintain social distancing. More information on the exact details will be sent home in the coming weeks.

Unfortunately this event will look different to previous years as it will now be taking place at school during lunchtime. The students will still be able to celebrate in style and reflect on their time here at Mount Keira Demonstration School.

School Leaders' speeches
