Invoices

This survey is done annually and provides valuable information and feedback to the school about your perspectives on your child's education and experiences. Dance2BFit program

Our whole school dance program commenced last Friday and runs for eight weeks. This program will supplement our PDHPE component of the curriculum. Each class will participate in a lesson each Friday. Dance is a mandatory component of the curriculum and it is expected that all students participate. The cost of the program is \$30 per student. This cost will appear on the Term 4 invoice. The dances the students will be learning are part of our **end of year concert**.

Coding Program

Once again this term all students will participate in a five week Coding program with our contractors Scope IT. Lessons commenced last Tuesday. The cost of the program (\$60 for the older students and \$30 for Kindergarten) will appear on the Term 4 invoice. We are excited to see the growth of the students over the past few years as they build on their knowledge to complete more complex projects. We look forward to seeing what they achieve this term.

End of Year Concert Save the Date

It is with great excitement and anticipation that we will once again be having our end of year concert at Mount Keira Demonstration School. Our theme this year is appropriately named 'Together Again', with Dance2bfit teaching each class their dance every Friday as part of the PE curriculum for Term 4. Please lock in Wednesday 30 November in your diaries for the concert. More details will be sent out in the coming weeks. Our Choir ensemble (K-6) has also begun rehearsing on Tuesdays and Fridays with Mrs Robinson.

Our school concert incorporates many elements of the Creative Arts syllabus and provides opportunities for senior students to be involved in the planning and creative process of a whole school performance.

NAPLAN

At the end of last term, NAPLAN results were sent home to our Year 3 and Year 5 parents of the students that sat the NAPLAN assessment in May this year. These results provide information to teachers and parents on

what students know and can do. NAPLAN is a point in time diagnostic assessment. NAPLAN assesses aspects of literacy including reading, spelling, grammar and punctuation, and writing, as well as numeracy.


Halloween


